Last week, Zech visited two golf courses where turfgrass was allegedly compromised by UTA's fungicide. On Friday, June 5, he sent a Stop-Sale letter to customers.

"At this time, UTA is doing everything we can to provide answers for this situation, and we are taking steps to prevent further issues," Zech said.
